

TRIANGLES, SQUARES, CIRCLES AND LINES

WHAT?

Paint simple shapes and lines on stones or paper. Your child can help you cut or draw shapes and give you ideas for what designs they would like to use.

Place the shape stones in front of your child.
Observe how your child interacts with the different shapes and lines. If your child seems uninterested, try the activity another time when they're talking about shapes or

patterns.
